

Conditions of participation for applicants for the Corona fundraising campaign

„STAND TOGETHER“

Radsportverein Aue e.V., Bergstrasse 1, 08280 Aue, represented by CEO Markus Illmann (hereinafter referred to as "provider") organizes the Corona fundraising campaign „STAND TOGETHER". By submitting the online application form, each applicant accepts the following conditions of participation.

§ 1 Donation campaign

As a non-profit organization, the provider is entitled to collect donations. The amount of the donation is at the discretion of the donor. Every donation is welcome. The provider will use the donation exclusively for a specific purpose, i.e. pay out to people / companies that have been economically damaged by Corona. For this purpose, the provider first makes a preselection after receiving the applications, whereby, among other things, the decisive factor is who, from the provider's point of view, needs support most urgently. This pre-selection of applicants will be presented on the standtogether.earth website. Every finalist receives a basic donation in the amount of 2000 € in september. Additionally they get their personal direct donations. It's possible to donate directly to a finalist with their "name" as purpose.

§ 2 Eligibility to Participate / Exclusion

Applicants who are of legal age are eligible to participate, i.e. persons who have reached the age of 18 at the time of participation and who are domiciled in Germany. Companies based in Germany are also eligible to participate. Employees of the provider and their relatives are excluded from participation. It is decisive for participation that the applicant has proven economic damage as a result of the corona pandemic.

All applicants undertake to provide completely truthful information in the context of their application, i.e. when sending the online application form and any subsequent correspondence with the provider.

In the event of a violation of the conditions of participation, incorrect information in the context of participation or other important reasons, the participant may be excluded from participation. If necessary, in these cases a payment of the donation amount can be refused or a reimbursement of a donation already made can be made. The decision about this is at the discretion of the provider.

The closing date for entries is 08/31/2021. The date on which the online application form was sent is decisive. The electronically recorded receipt by the provider is used to check that the deadline has been met.

Each applicant may only send the online application form once. For companies, too, only one online application can be sent.

§ 3 Selection / transmission of the donation

The provider first makes a pre-selection of the applicants. This pre-selection of applicants will be presented on the standtogether.earth website.

Applicants who receive a dividend will be notified in writing within four weeks of the end of the fundraising campaign, but no later than October 1st, 2021. Applicants will contact the provider by email within 4 weeks of receipt of the notification at the email address standtogether@erzgebirgstour.com and provide their bank details for the payment. After these 4 weeks the payment entitlement expires. Payment claims are not transferable.

§ 4 Granting of rights

All applicants agree to the publication of the data they have transmitted to the provider as part of their application on the internet on the website standtogether.earth and in the provider's profiles on social networks, whereby the provider only uses the applicant's initials, their place of residence and a brief summary of the reasons for participating in the donation campaign.

§ 5 Data protection

The provider uses SSL encryption techniques when transmitting data. Applicants agree that the provider stores the required personal data for the duration and for the purpose of carrying out and processing the donation campaign.

§ 6 Disclaimer

The provider offers his services with the greatest possible care and reliability. However, he does not guarantee that his services will always be accessible without interruption.

The provider is fully liable for intent, malice and gross negligence as well as in the case of personal injury. In the event of a slightly negligent breach of essential contractual obligations (cardinal obligations), the provider is limited to the amount of the contract-typical and foreseeable damage. Cardinal obligations within the meaning of this regulation are the main contractual performance obligations as well as obligations the fulfillment of which enables the proper execution of the contract concluded between the provider and the donors in the first place and which they can regularly rely on compliance with the agreement. In this case, however, the provider is not liable for lost profit, indirect damage, consequential damage caused by defects and / or claims by third parties. For all other cases the liability of the provider is excluded.

§ 7 Final provisions

The legal recourse is not applicable. The law of the Federal Republic of Germany applies exclusively. Should individual provisions of these general terms and conditions be or become ineffective, this shall not affect the effectiveness of the remaining provisions. Rather, the statutory regulation applies instead of each invalid provision. The same applies to incompleteness.
